
If there are restrictions on an eprints, it should appear like this:

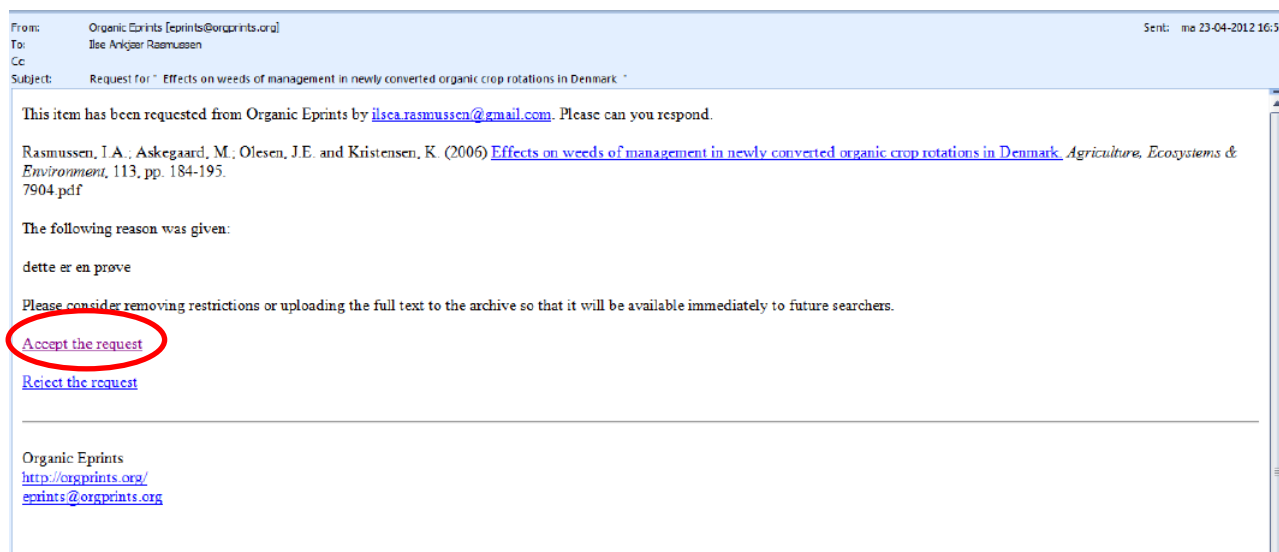

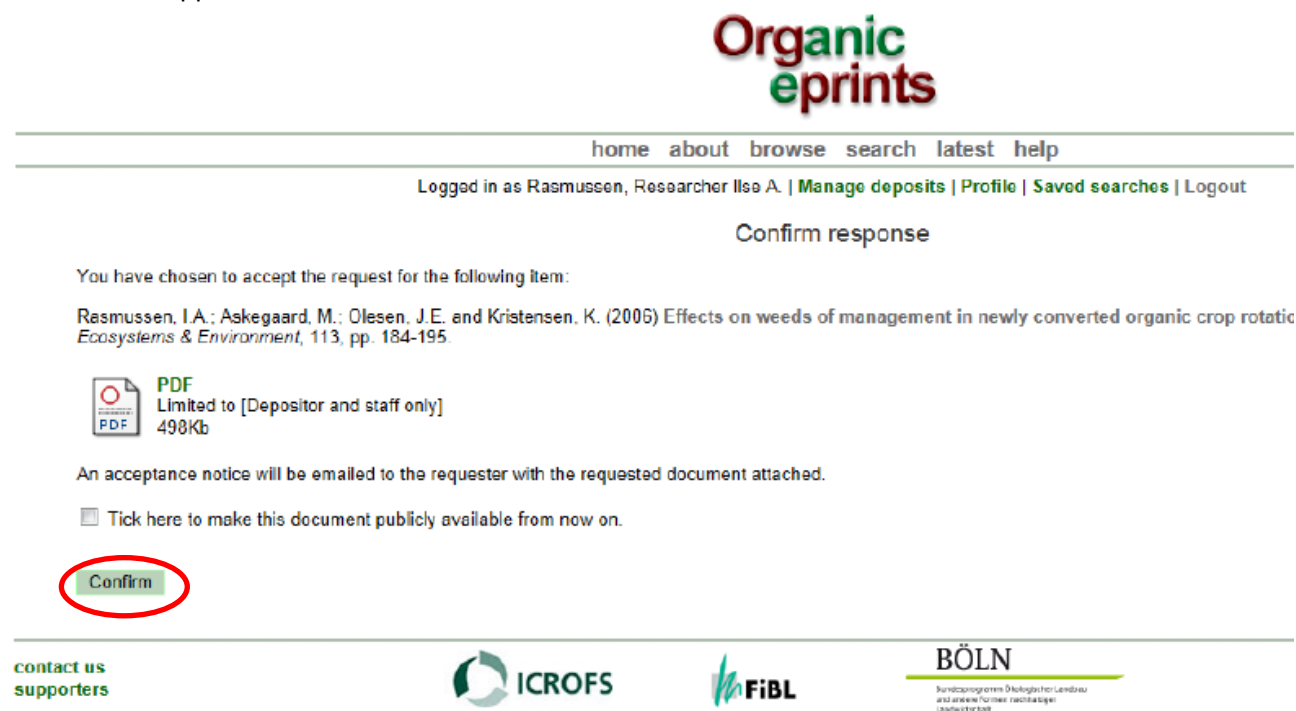
