

## **Countries Drafting Organic Regulation**








## **US: 80 approved CBs**



### Certification Bodies recognized for US NOP certification








## EU: 54 approved CBs for imports

# Trends in regulations: Bilateral agreements among governments


- > Based on Equivalency
- Critial points are usually excluded (e.g. antibiotics)

- **US US CAN (2009)** 
  - **> US EU (2012)**
  - > US Japan (2014)
  - > US Korea (2014)
  - > US Switzerland (2015)
- **EU Switzerland (2002 trade agreement)** 
  - > Canada (2011)
  - > US (2012)
  - > Korea (2015)
- **CAN** US (2009)
  - > EU (2011)
  - > Switzerland (2012)
  - > Costa Rica (2013)
  - > Japan (2015)



# Trends in regulations: Bilateral agreements among governments

- Agreeements among few active players/strong markets
- > Ensuring market access both ways

### **Trends in Regulations: EU**



- > Strong efforts to strengthen control system
- Ongoing negotiations for revision of EU Regulation (Trilog)
  - > Imports still an issue of negotiations
- > Specific guidelines for additional controls for organic products from
  - Variable Variable



# Trends in Regulations: Eastern Europe/Central Asia

#### **>** EU:

- > Guidelines for additional controls for imports in EU
- > Guidelines for additional checks by CB's in the countries
- Withdrawal of recognition of ETKO (CB) due to serious deficiencies in the checks carried out and a substantial number of non-conformities
- > Ukraine: Law adopted but not implemented civil dialogue on revision
- > Kasachstan: New legislation adopted on 27.11.2015
- > Russia: Negotiations on draft ongoing



#### **Outlook**

- > Revision of EU Regulation most likely completed in 2016
- Revised import scheme in EU (transition period still in negtiation)
- > Bilateral agreements seeked with relevant export countries
