The Organic Farm Knowledge platform provides access to a wide range of tools and resources about diverse topics related to organic farming. The platform promotes the exchange of knowledge among farmers, farm advisers, and scientists, with the aim of increasing productivity, quality and sustainability of organic farming within Europe. The core of the Organic Farm Knowledge platform is the toolbox, where all tools can be searched according to the interests of the user.

The toolbox provides access to a variety of resources (“Tools”) for organic farmers and advisors. The type of these tools ranges from leaflets, videos, podcasts, calculation tools, etc. The toolbox can be searched using the arbitrary text field or by keyword, theme, language, organisation, project, tool type, etc. The tools were selected by or created in various projects and institutions.

The platform has over 9,000 visits per month, with this number growing steadily. Whether you are farming, advising, researching or teaching, within the field of organic farming and food systems, you can benefit greatly from the knowledge available on the platform.
